The Nobi Nobi Checkup (Specific Medical Examination) and the National Health Insurance Comprehensive Medical Examination

Saitama City residents ages 40-74 who are enrolled in National Health Insurance are eligible to receive either the "Nobi Nobi Checkup (Specific Medical Examination)" or the "National Health Insurance Comprehensive Medical Examination". Once per year, a doctor chosen by Saitama City will assess your health.

Saitama City will send an envelope with a "Nobi Nobi Checkup (Specific Medical Examination) Ticket" to your home at the end of every April. If you enroll in National Health Insurance between the end of March and the end of January, the ticket will be mailed to you the following month. Please contact your Ward Office's National Health Insurance and Pension Division if you do not receive or have lost your ticket.

The checkup will take place between April 27, 2025 and March 14, 2026. You may receive one checkup during this period. Be sure to take advantage of this service!

Make an appointment at a clinic with one of the doctors designated by Saitama City. See the "List of Medical Institutions Administering the Nobi Nobi Checkup (Specific Medical Examination)" included with your ticket or visit Saitama City's website for information on where to receive your checkup.
