

Fires can occur in collection vehicles and crushing facilities. If a crushing facility were damaged, not only would the processing stop, it would also cost a lot to restore the facility.

The fire that occurred at the Sakura Environmental Center in April 2023 cost 30 million yen to restore.

Garbage collection trucks are also expensive, costing around 20 million yen for each unit.

Recycling of recyclable resources from households

After delivery, recyclables undergo intermediate processing as follows for each type.

Why are they sorted by color? (glass wool)

Sorting by color helps to transform items as recycled products more efficiently. For example, most white and brown bottles are recycled into bottles again. Other colored bottles are often transformed as other products besides bottles.

After purchase, coupons cannot be reissued and refunds cannot be made. To prevent the illicit use of tickets, each ticket is designed to break if removed after it is put on an item of trash. Please note that damaged tickets cannot be used.

* Only household waste is collected. *One reservation per household (up to 4). *For one-time large amounts of waste due to moving, etc., see page 8. Collection will be conducted even on rainy days.

Other items that the city cannot collect or dispose of

Please consult with a retailer, manufacturer, or specialized dealer concerning items that cannot be collected or disposed of by the city.

• Waste that can be explosive or flammable [Examples] gas cylinders, petroleum / gasoline, mineral fuel such as kerosene, etc.

Hazardous waste [Example] volatile oil, agrichemicals, powerful drugs, chemicals, etc.

Garbage that may carry risk of infection, such as medical injection needles. [Example]: Insulin injection needles, drip infusion needles for personal use, etc.

→ Return it to the medical institution (hospital, clinic, dispensing pharmacy) that issued the prescription.

Disposing of the above three types of wastes at a household waste collection station can lead to serious accidents involving the lives of collection workers and disp facility staff, so make sure to consult with the store, manufacturer, or specialized dealer.

Equipment containing Freon

This is a system in which city officials visit homes to pick up garbage for people who cannot bring their own garbage to collection stations, such as seniors, people with disabilities, etc.

Applicable persons

- Seniors: Elderly people aged 65 and above who live alone.
- Person with disability: A person with a disability who lives alone.
- *Family members living together with elderly or disabled persons are eligible if the family member is elderly or disabled and cannot dispose of the garbage to the collection station.
- *This may not be applicable to those who have relatives, siblings, or children living nearby who can take out the garbage.

Collection method

- As a general rule, garbage is collected once a week from the front door, etc.
- Burnable waste, unburnable waste, harmful and dangerous waste, and recyclables type 1 and 2 will be collected. Large-sized waste, and items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators / freezers,
- washing machines / dryers), as well as items that are difficult to dispose of at city facilities such as motorcycles, etc., and one-time large amounts of waste due to moving places, etc., cannot be collected.

Application

- After consulting with the Area Sanitation Office in-charge, the person who will use the service or a proxy should submit the "Fureai (rapport) collection use application form".
- 2)A city official will visit the applicant's home to investigate the situation, and if the use is approved, collection will begin.

Regarding the matter of "reuse", utilizing the services of private business operators

The city of Saitama is working with private business operators to promote the reuse of unwanted items. Users can search for stores or recipients of items using a smartphone or computer without incurring disposal fees.

Please take out garbage to the designated collection station by 8:30 in the morning (5:30 a.m. in districts that collect burnable waste early in the morning), following the sorting method and the type of bag to be used. Also, make sure to properly drain the water from raw garbage and tie the mouth of the garbage bag before disposing. If an anti-crow protection net is installed, please cooperate in keeping the place clean by putting it on properly when disposing of garbage. Garbage duty is conducted at some collection points. Household waste collection points are for household wastes only, and all business wastes cannot be disposed of in this area,
